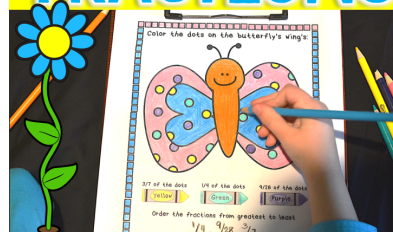

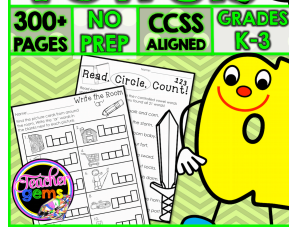

Make learning fun and interactive with Boom Cards™ Digital Task Cards that you can use on a computer, interactive whiteboard, tablet or other device.

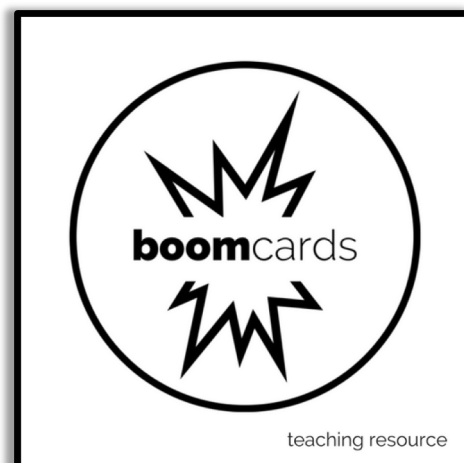
Step 1: Create an Account

Just like you need to have a Google account in order to use Google slides, you will need to create a Boom Learning account to use Boom Cards. You can create an account for free or upgrade for more features like student progress monitoring.

Free accounts include the ability to generate student progress reports for 5 students and to make up to 5 DIY decks. Free accounts include the ability to assign Boom Cards to unlimited students (without progress reports) using the Fast Play pin option (see following pages for an explanation of Fast Pins).

If you are new to Boom Learning, you will receive a 90-day free premium upgrade that includes student progress reports for up to 150 students. At the end of the trial period, you will be invited to purchase the upgrade. If you do not, you will be moved to a free account. You may upgrade, downgrade or cancel at any time. If you do not upgrade, you can continue using your purchased Boom Cards with Fast Play.

Click on the Boom Cards image to redeem your purchase (and to create an account if you haven't already).





Step 2: Set up a "Classroom"

Click on "Classes" to set up a new classroom. Give your classroom a name and add your students. Students will receive individual accounts which they can login to and access the decks you assign to them.

Step 3: Assign Decks to Students

Once you have created an account and redeemed your purchase it will show up in your "Library" as a "Deck". Decks are just the name given to the full set of Boom Cards included in a product.

Step 4: Use Your Boom Cards!

Provide students with their username (found under their name) and password (you can change a student password by clicking the plus sign next to their name to view the menu with the option to change a password). Students play the game or complete the task cards that you assigned to them on a tablet, computer or other device. You can download the free app to play or use the Boom Learning website where you set up your account.
